Credits

Our courses are designed and run on the basis of ECTS principles. All our language courses contain assessments as a means of evaluating course participants' learning progress. ECTS credits are only awarded if there has been a formal assessment of a course participant's performance.

ECTS credits are awarded only once for any given course. Participants can only repeat a course if they have previously failed to meet the requirements of a given course or if they have previously failed a course.

ECTS points are only awarded to participants who demonstrate progress in their learning in connection with a course and whose progress has been assessed as part of the course.

Recognition and accreditation

The Language Center issues Certificates of Achievement to course participants who have successfully completed a course in modern languages. Certificates can be used for accreditation purposes at participants' home universities, where relevant.
